## Randy Broedel

- 26000 Acre feet of water part of CSKT water rights (soverein nation)
- Top 8.5 ft. below full pool
- Water goes into 4 different reservoirs: LBL, Hubbard, Dry creek 1&2
- Water levels have not been maintained
- (Depeartment of Interior) above BIA. BIA over FIIP
- \$900 million over 10 years to FIIP. Dam is in need of repair
- Communication between Ryan Zinke and Flathead County Commissioners and others
- Commissioners would like to see the Bureu of Reclamation govern in this process.
- The dam has been open since atleast February 2025.

Questions for Commissioner Broedel:

Water level at both boat launches are a challenge.

The two streams that fill the lake are not refilling the lake?

Is there funding for 24/7 check stations?

- \*Bring in a porta potty for events larger than your septic can handle. Most systems are designed for 3 bedroom

- FIIP developed from the ground up
- Be a part of system,
- Core of FIIP in St. Ignasius
- Be at the meetings, ask the good questions,
- Water management is about data.
- Can't be anti FIIP Budget comes from fees charged to water users.
- Who will be our data gatherer? Who will be our liaison with FIIP and others?
- Water Compact with Tribe 1.8 bill. To SKT Not to BIA. 10s of millions used Heavy structure
